Hat Sizes and Measurements

We know that choosing a hat of the correct size is especially important when ordering online. We figure, since heads come in all shapes and sizes, there's no such thing as an "average" hat size. We want you to feel confident that you're ordering a hat that will fit you well. Use the following information to decide which size hat will fit you best.

Calculating Your Hat Size

To calculate your hat size, a measurement of your head circumference should be taken in inches or centimeters. This is best achieved by wrapping a cloth tape measure around the head. You can also use a piece of string that you'll then measure against a ruler or tape measure. It's important that this measurement is taken where your hat would normally rest. To take the measurement, position the tape measure or string so it rests just above the brow at the front of the head, touching the top of the ears at the side. Pull the tape so that is taught but not too tight and take a measurement. Depending on how you like your hats to fit, rather tight or a bit loose, you may want to move into the next size up or down depending where your measurement falls in the chart below.

Hat Size Conversion Chart
