



RECURVE STRINGER INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1



Attach the limbs to the bow with the plastic washer side of the limb against the bolt. The bottom limb has the bow weight and length marked on it.

Step 2




The larger loop goes on the top limb and the short loop should stay on the bottom limb.

Stand on the bowstringer in the center with both feet. Pull the handle riser upward with one hand and with the other hand slide the string up the limb and into the groove.

Slowly relax the upward pressure on the bow while making sure the bowstring stays in the string notch.


To unstring simply reverse last step.



Slip the bottom limb of your bow all the way to the bottom of the leather pouch.




Place the upper bow limb between the two strings and the rubber side of the leather strap. Position the stringer between the handle riser and the bowstring as close to the bowstring as possible.



Before stringing, your bow should be looking like this. The string should be in the notch on the bottom limb.
