

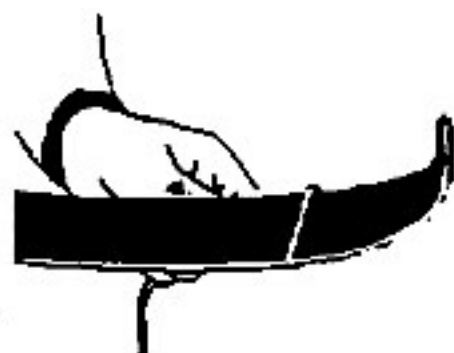
# How to Use the Recurve Bowstringer

1.



Slip the large string loop over the end of the upper limb.

2.



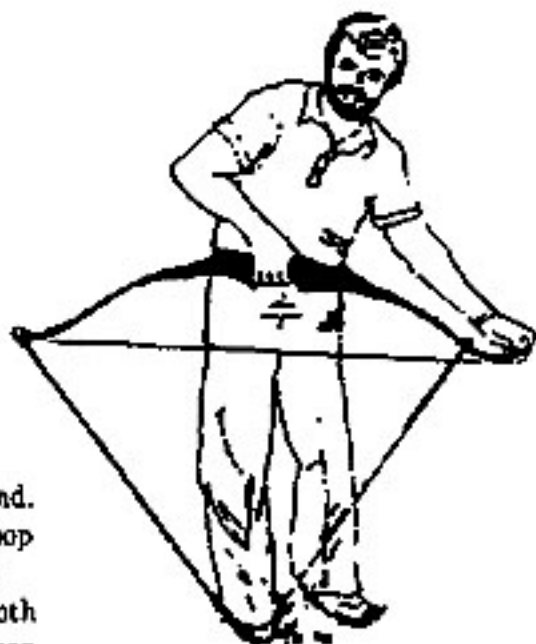
Pull the string loop down several inches, or until you can't pull it down any further.

3.



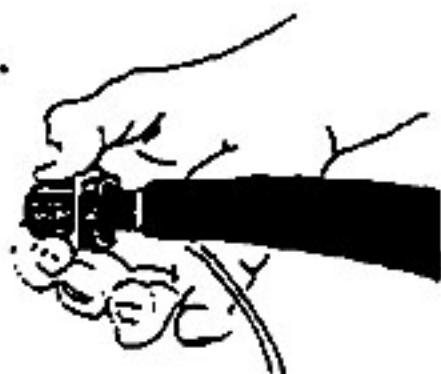
Place the smaller string loop on the lower limb tip. Make sure that the string is securely seated in the limb tip grooves.

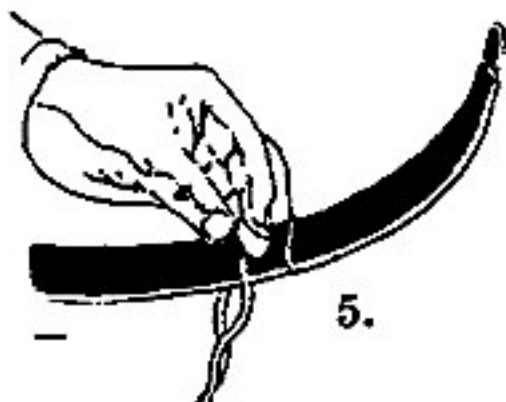
Step on the bowstring cord with your right foot and pull the handle upward with your right hand. While the bow is flexed, slide the large string loop down to the limb tip and carefully seat it in the limb tip grooves. Once you have checked that both ends of the bowstring are properly seated, you can relax the tension and remove the bowstringer.

4.



Place the rubber cup of the bowstringer over the lower limb tip. Be sure not to dislodge the string from the grooves as you cover the limb tip with the rubber cup. The cord of the bowstringer should be on the same side of the limb as the bowstring.

5.



Place the rubber limb gripper on the upper limb, about a half-inch closer to the handle than the string loop.
